The above referenced site is a fuel leak case that is under the regulatory oversight of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Local Oversight Program for the investigation and cleanup of a release of petroleum hydrocarbons from an underground storage tank system. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and the site has been evaluated in accordance with the State Water Resources Control Board Low-Threat Closure Policy.
