The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Solid/Medical Waste Management, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has received and accepted for issuance per Title 14 California Code of Regulations (CCR) Section 18104.2, a Registration Permit Application for Tri-CED Community Recycling Facility.

Permit Description

Tri-City Economic Development Corporation submitted a registration permit application for a new Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility that will accept and process up to 100 tons per day of commingled or source-separated residential and commercial recyclables. The days and hours of operations of the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) are Monday through Sunday, from 12:00AM to 11:59PM. The MRF is not open to the general public. The facility size encompasses 4.91 acres while the operating area is 3.22 acres. The registration permit will be issued within five (5) days from finding the application complete and correct on October 15, 2020.
